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Definitions

- » **Medicaid Managed Long-Term Services and Supports (MLTSS):** If the state has or is implementing MLTSS, the almanac indicates where the state is in the process.
- » **Dual-Alignment MLTSS:** If the state has or is implementing dual-alignment MLTSS, the almanac indicates where the state is in the process.
- » **Waivers:**
 - **Section 1115:** The state has a current Section 1115 waiver, which combines extensive waiver authority with a broadly defined purpose for which waivers may be granted.²
 - **Section 1915(b):** The state has a current Section 1915(b) waiver, which allows states to implement a managed care delivery. There are four types of 1915(b) waivers³:
 - ♦ **(b)(1) Freedom of Choice:** Restricts Medicaid enrollees from receiving services with the managed care network.
 - ♦ **(b)(2) Enrollment Broker:** Allows a county or local government to act as a broker to help people in Medicaid select a managed care plan.
 - ♦ **(b)(3) Non-Medicaid Services Waiver:** Uses cost savings to provide additional services to beneficiaries.
 - ♦ **(b)(4) Selective Contracting Waiver:** Restricts the provider from whom those who are Medicaid-eligible may obtain services.
- » **Section 1915(c):** The state has a current 1915(c) waiver, which allows states to obtain waivers of comparability requirements, in order to offer home and community-based services to limited groups of enrollees as an alternative to institutional care.⁴
