## Licensure

### Definitions

- » **PACE Federal Regulation:** PACE organizations must meet the PACE federal regulation with no additional requirements
- » **State PACE License:** In addition to the PACE federal regulation, the state has created a specific license for PACE organizations.
- » **ADC:** In addition to the PACE federal regulation, PACE organizations must meet the requirements of the adult day care license in their state.
- » **Primary Care Clinic:** In addition to the federal regulation, PACE organizations must meet the state's primary care clinic license.
- » **Home Health:** In addition to the PACE federal regulation, PACE organizations must meet the requirements of the home health license in their state.
- » **Other:** In addition to the PACE federal regulation, PACE organizations must meet an additional licensure requirement (not captured in the chart).

<sup>1</sup> California has a process in place to request exemptions for the various licensures.

<sup>2</sup> For-profit PACE organizations do not qualify for clinic licenses.

<sup>3</sup> The PACE organization must also have a pharmacy license.

<sup>4</sup> The PACE organization must have an HMO license.
